£6.2 million was spent on refurbishing the Office for National Statistics Newport office as part of a regular programme of improvement and to prepare for hybrid ways of working following the pandemic. The investment is more than offset over a ten year period, due to a 20% reduction in workspace and other changes to maximise productivity and effectiveness.

£1.2 million was spent on office space that was no longer in use by 1 December 2023, as workspace was further reduced to respond to hybrid-working changes and drive efficiency. Our workspace design is modular: and can be increased, reduced, or changed as necessary to support future workspace decisions. This future-proofing approach allowed notice to be served in 2022 to release surplus workspace back to the Landlord, with significant savings to ONS.
